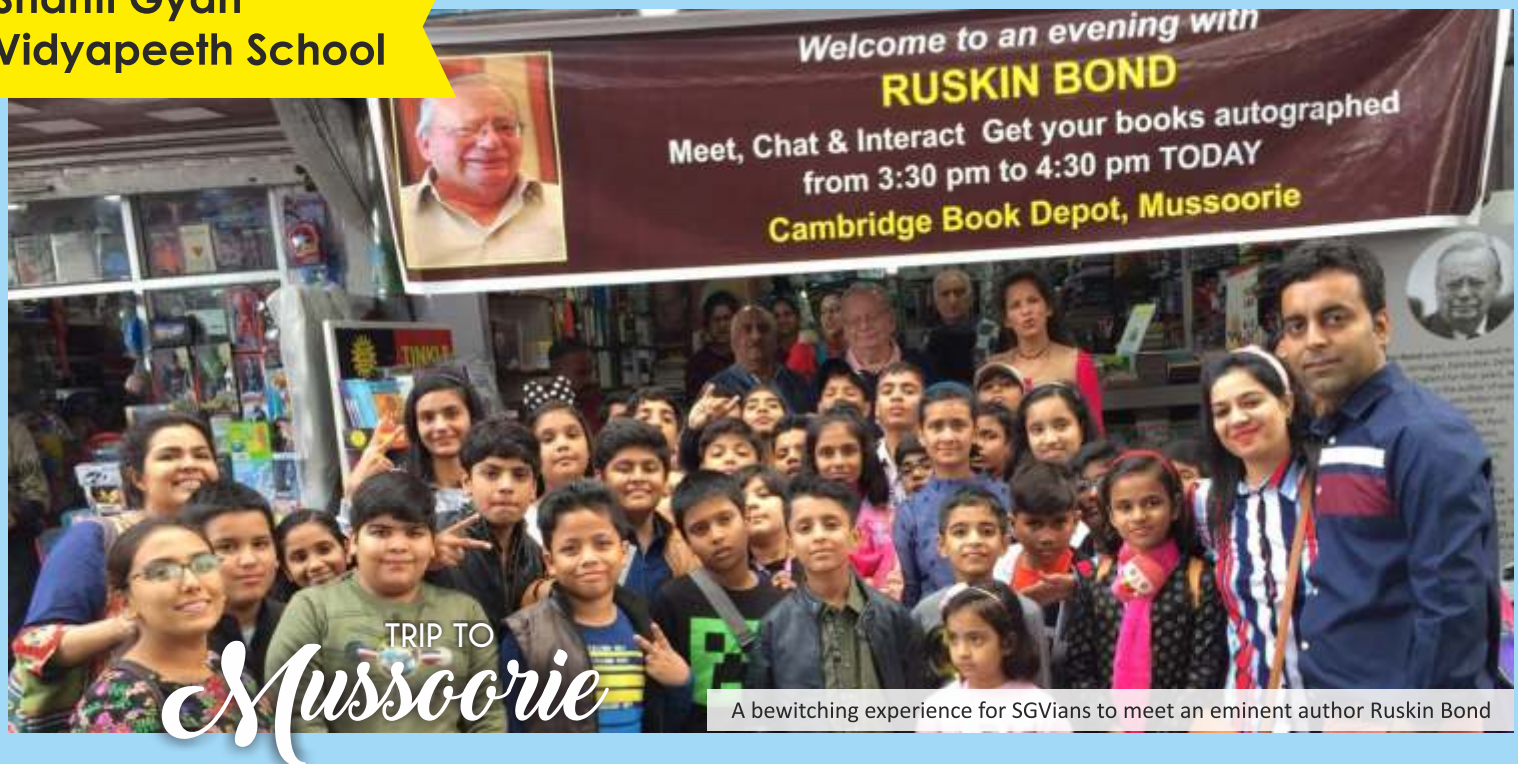
Teacher's Workshop

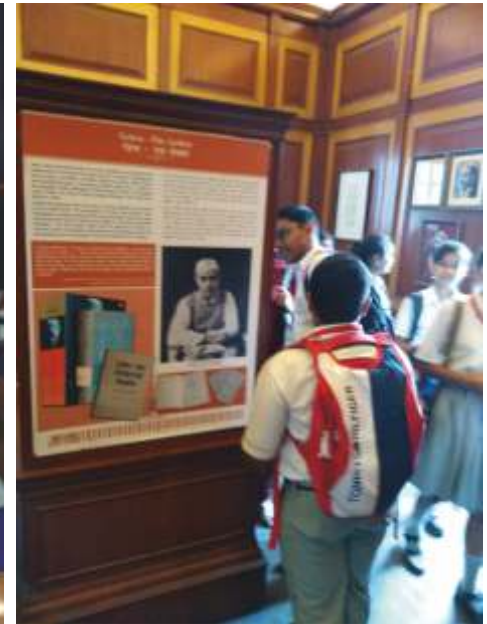


Nehru Planetarium & Teen Murti Bhawan
